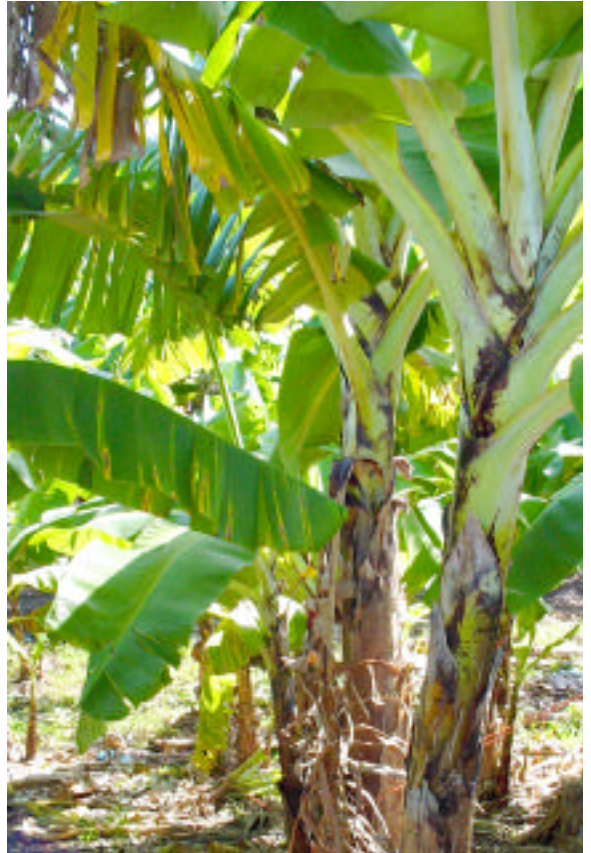

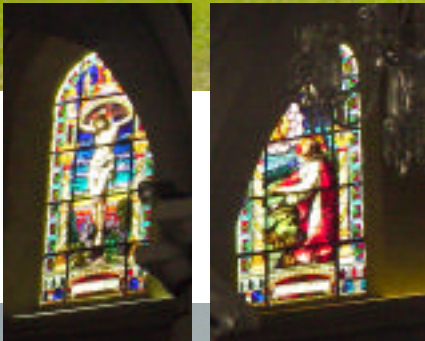
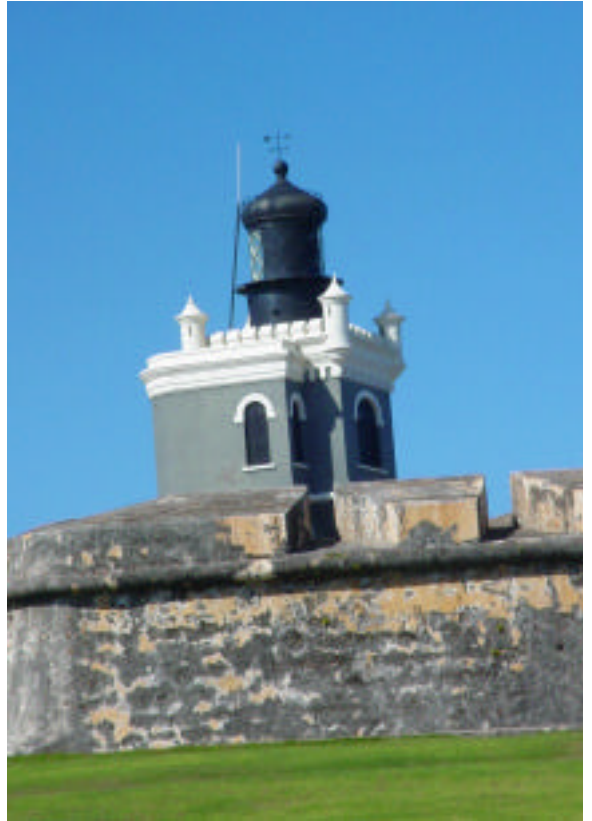






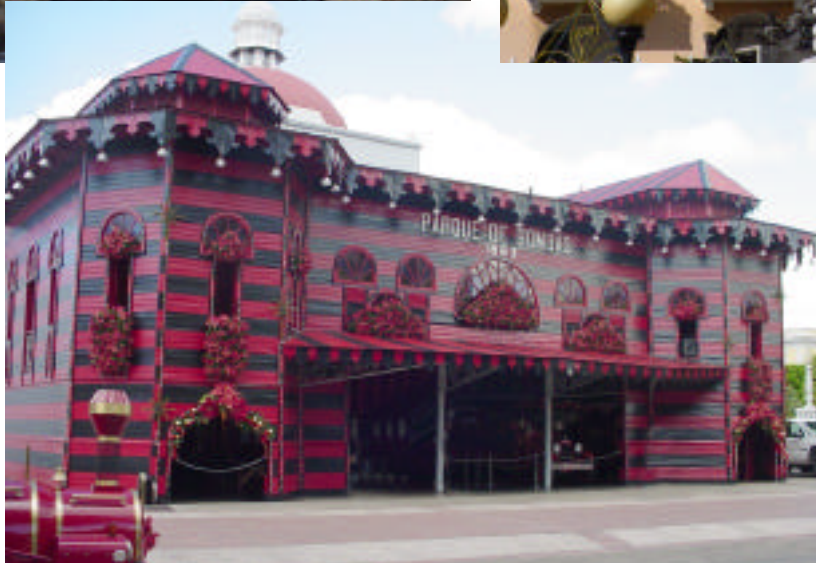














Top: a lookout in Ponce. Left: a stop sign ("pare") and street signs in San Juan.
